Her husband has gone abroad for better earnings, but the money he sends is not etiquette to take good care of her family. They have very small land on which they have their small home. They do not have other sources of income.

Anuja always wanted to do some work. But since she didn't have proper knowledge or skills in any professional work, she was forced to stay home and look after her family. She had seen Beauty Parlours and thought this could be a great choice for her too. But she didn't have enough money to stay in Kathmandu city and train on this.

Fortunately, one of her neighbors (IDEA Nepal leader) informed her about the "Beautician Training." She joyfully applied, had an interview, and had this opportunity to learn. She is learning with great enthusiasm. She states that this is the right training for her. It is her passion to be a beautician and she wants her own small business in the future. Now, she is happy that she is living her dream.
